2016 Ripley County Queen Pageant

Terms & Conditions:

1. Each contestant must be at least 16 years of age and cannot have had their 21st birthday as of August 7, 2016 the first day of the 2016 Indiana State Fair Queen Pageant.
2. Each contestant must be an Indiana resident, a U.S. citizen, and represent her home county. One of the contestant's parents or legal guardians must also be an Indiana resident.
3. Each contestant must be an active member of at least one worthwhile organization in their community, such as church groups, Scouts, 4-H, etc. Eligibility is not limited to 4-H membership.
4. No professional model is eligible for the Ripley County Queen Pageant. (A professional model is one who earns her livelihood by modeling.) A contestant who has had training or schooling in the modeling field, has been paid on occasion for modeling or works for a fashion board is not considered a professional model.
5. Any contestant who has competed in a State Fair Queen Pageant cannot compete again.
6. Transportation for contestants and chaperones to and from the pageant will be the responsibility of each contestant.
7. Contestants will be judged in professional wear and formal wear, and on personal interviews conducted in the afternoon and evening of Sunday, July 17, 2016

8. Contestants are required to participate in four **pre-pageant** activities.

Queen's Tea – Friday, June 17, 2016

Queen Bee Slumber Party – Friday, June 17, 2016

Mock Interview Night – June 28, 2016

Pageant Rehearsal – July 16, 2016 (subject to change and time TBA)

9. Court members are required to participate in the following activities:

After Pageant meeting – Monday, July 18, 2016 at The Grub Company (each contest
is to bring a parent or guardian)

Opening Ceremonies – Sunday, July 24, 2016

Ripley County 4-H Fair – July 24-30, 2016

10. No one is allowed to leave Queen's Bee Slumber Party unless Committee has approval
from parent or guardian.

11. The Queen's Tea is a mandatory event for each contestant. The only exception for this is
if the contestant has made arrangements with the committee for a family function, school
function, or family emergency.

12. Rehearsal is also mandatory event. Family emergency will be excused.

13. Judges – After the pageant each contestant has the right to go speak with the judges
back stage. However, when speaking with the judges this is an opportunity to improve
on what they feel you can improve on this is not a time to ask the judges what they liked
or did not like about you as an individual. The judges score sheets will be shredded
immediately following the pageant, no contestant or anyone other than Amanda and
Monica will see them.

14. At any time the committee reserves the right to dismiss a contestant or court member if we feel the behavior of the contestant is inappropriate. This will be a vote with the entire committee and will be discussed with the fair board upon our decision. (We have never had to do this but reserve the right at anytime.)

15. REMEMBER this pageant is meant to be a great time!! We have an amazing time getting to know each other and have a lot of fun laughing and making new friends. We hope this is a rewarding experience for you as much as it is for us.
